15th Annual Bremen Pumpkin Walk

Here's an opportunity to get out and enjoy the season with family, friends and neighbors.

It starts with applying your artistic talent by carving a pumpkin to make a jack-o-lantern.



Pumpkins will be provided free of charge. All you need to do is bring your family and carving utensils to the Bremen Rushcreek Fire Station **on Thursday October 12 and/or Friday October 13, from 6 to 8 p.m.**

Adult supervision is required for the carving.

Your finished jack-o-lanterns will be displayed along the paved walking path at Howell Park **on Saturday, October 14, from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m.** We are anticipating well over 100 lit pumpkins will line the path. Musical entertainment will be provided by Crystal D'Lites and guitarist Josh Taylor.



Leaf Collection

The Village crew will soon begin autumn leaf collection. Due to the sheer volume of leaves during the peak of the season, it's not possible for the crew to cover the entire town each week. 


Leaves to be collected should be piled behind the curb, not in the gutter or street. Leaves in streets can clog storm sewer drains and lead to high water problems as well as costly maintenance problems.



Attention Dog Owners

Many laws in Ohio deal with dog ownership and treatment, including both state statutes and local ordinances. **Dogs are not allowed to run loose.** They are required to be under someone's control. Furthermore, for those of you who walk your dog along the streets, on sidewalks and in other public areas, please remember to pick up after your pet has done its business.

To report a stray and/or aggressive dog during weekdays 9:00 AM – 6:00 PM, call the County Dog Warden at 740-687-3647. Outside those hours, call the county sheriff's office at 740-652-7900, extension 2. If it's a life-threatening situation, call 911.
