17th Annual Bremen Pumpkin Walk

It starts with applying your artistic talent by carving a pumpkin to make a jack-o-lantern. Pumpkins will be provided free of charge. All you need to do is bring your family and carving utensils to the Bremen Rushcreek Fire Station **on Thursday October 10 and/or Friday October 11, from 6 to 8 p.m.**

Adult supervision is required for the carving.

Your finished jack-o-lanterns will be displayed along the paved walking path at Howell Park **on Saturday, October 12, from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.**

All of the festivities from 6pm to 8pm at the park are free, but donations will be accepted and much appreciated.

5K Pumpkin Run



October 12th is also the date of this year's Run which starts and ends at Howell Park. Race-day registration begins at 4:45, with the 5k starting at 5:30 PM.

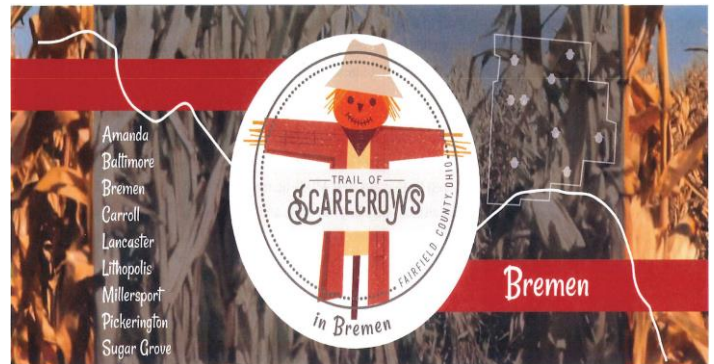
