- 1)Discussed CT Consultants proposal for step1 analysis of storm sewer problem for Bartlett St and Spring St area Drainage. It is estimated to take approximately 2 months for Engineers to come up with a plan. This will also include possible funding sources. Engineering plan to cost approximately \$10,000. Unanimous decision for Jeff to sign off for CT Consultants to start plan.
- 2) During the big rain, Chance pumped 10,000,000 gallons of water around the sewer plant in 4 days.
- 3) Mary Hoffman discussed plans for Dowling Park, Poles to come out, save Bi Centennial Plague, what to do with a/c's on Jeff Wilson's bldg., decided to let engineers to take out the old fountain instead of volunteers, not knowing what's under it, Flag pole must come out and be moved.
- 4) Discussed need to get all water meters and shut off moved to outside of building for ease of access.
- 5) Can see several sink holes appear to be starting, must keep an eye on them. Had a big one on Rt 664n, looked like someone drilled through storm sewer line to run water line to house back in '94, this caused a big collapse.
- 6)Columbia Gas line replacement project had to go back to the drawing board because of too many tree roots. They may have to go down the sidewalks. Yea!!!!, some new sidewalks in town??!!!!!
