

**Record of Proceedings
Village of Bremen Special Council Meeting
July 27, 2018**

The Council of the Village of Bremen was called to order in special session by Mayor Mike Henwood at 6:00 P.M. The council and visitors stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The public has been given an hour-long hearing to ask questions and discuss the budget. The Clerk-Treasurer went through the proposed budget line by line. It was decided that the payments to Lester Sharp for the soccer field lease would be paid from 1000-320-399-0000 instead of 1000-715-420-0000. It just makes sense to everyone that this be paid out of the Parks object lines instead of the legislative lines. There was a typographical error in the sewer fund leading to incorrect totals. The discussed changes were made to the tax budget.
