New Business:

New budget - tree budget has approximately 8,000 in the budget for the year, for trimming, stump removal and planting.

Tree removals – Mayor and Tripp assessed the village for tree hazards. We identified several trees that need to be removed this year. We will get quotes for the removals for the larger trees. Village Workers will remove the small or medium sized ASH trees that are dead.

Tree Planting - Talked about tree planting – Tripp has the PO for the park tree planting on the westend of Howell Park (McCandlish Property) 5 medium sized Honey Locusts will be planted there by the Boy Scouts of Troop 93. Eagle Scout Candidate Charles Gordon has completed collecting funds for his project and there have been trees purchased and planted around the walking track.

2021 Arbor Day Ceremony went well, the Householder Memorial Tree was planted and paid for by donations from Charles Gordon's Eagle Scout project.
